

## Down:

- A literary advisor for an opera. They help research the history and text to help give an informed performance
- A rehearsal focused on integrating the singers and the orchestra. Singers sit and sing their music, rather than doing their staging
- The lowest voice type in operatic singing.
  They often play fathers, wise men, and villains
- 6. The assembled crowd observing an opera
- 7. A piece in an opera sung by five people

## Across:

- A group of notes all set to the same syllable of text
- A person, especially a young person who is exceptionally skilled
- The clothing that is worn by an opera singer when playing a character
- A pause or break in a performance
- The highest sound in music. Traditionally the upper clef in piano music
- 11. A Czech composer who lived between 1824 and 1884. He helped popularize Czech opera written in Czech rather than German. Famous works include "The Bartered Bride (Prodana Nevesta)" and "The Kiss (Hubička)."
- 12. A series of notes creating the "tune" of a piece
